THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND FINANCE'S ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST ISSUED TO KHANNA, INC., d/b/a RMC FINANCIAL.COM, HAYWARD, CA, BECOMES FINAL

Atlanta, Georgia — On November 19, 2007, an Order to Cease and Desist issued by the Georgia Department of Banking and Finance ("Department") to KHANNA, Inc., d/b/a RMC Financial.com, Hayward, CA became final.

This Order to Cease and Desist was issued by the Department after it obtained evidence that KHANNA, Inc., d/b/a RMC Financial.com, engaged in mortgage broker/lending activities without a license or under an applicable exemption.

Pursuant to Georgia law, it is prohibited for any person knowingly to purchase, sell, or transfer a mortgage loan or loan application from or to an entity that is not licensed or exempt from licensing or registration provisions to engage in mortgage broker/lender activities.
